At 6:45 pm, Mayor Pro tem Wilkes made a motion with a second by Councilman Klaus to return to regular session. Executive Session matters were taken as information.



Adjournment


With no further business to discuss, Councilman Klaus made a motion with a second by Councilman Sanders that the meeting be adjourned. All voted aye.
