He complained about boards on buildings in the downtown area and overgrown grass behind the building on Congress Street.
- D. Brenda Miller and Vickie Dodds – Stated that Mount Zion property management was in progress. Brenda Miller stated that improvements were being made to bring people to Winnsboro. She said the Home and Garden Tour would be held May 16, 2015.
- E. Terry Vickers – She was present to follow up on Ag and Art. She stated that there was a good response and she requested money to come out of the Economic Development Fund. Mr. Ernest Manning also invited everyone to come to this event. Ms. Vickers asked Council to sponsor the Ag and Art event. Councilman Wilkes made a motion with a second by Councilman Miller for Town sponsorship. A request was also made to use space under Town Clock. Councilman Wilkes made a motion to permit usage of the Town Clock with a second by Councilman Miller.


**At 7:40 pm Councilman Klaus made a motion with a second by Councilman Sanders to return to regular session.**
