Call to Order

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Invocation

Councilman Clyde Sanders offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes

Councilman Klaus made a motion with a second by Councilman Wilkes that the minutes of the September 20, 2016, Finance Meeting and Town Council Meeting be approved as written. All voted aye.

New Business A. Contract Award- Water Plant: TOC & Chlorine Dioxide Grant Project: Connie Shackelford Ms. Shackelford discussed the bids for the Water Plant Improvements and stated the bids totaled more the grant amount. Ms. Shackelford stated a change order was being prepared to remove the PAC System at this time until additional funding became available. Councilman Sanders made a motion to award the bid to AAA Utility and Construction, LLC. The motion was seconded by Councilman Klaus and carried a unanimous vote.

Old Business –

- A. **Municipal Judge Reappointment & Oath of Office** – Senator Creighton Coleman gave the Oath of Office to newly re-appointed Judge Ernest M. Spong, III. Councilman Sanders asked the Judge if the town needed to have an attorney present at court to represent the town. Judge Spong replied that it would be helpful.

Other Business –

- A. **Upgrade of Public Safety Radios** – Major John Seibles addressed Council concerning the upgrading of the Palmetto 800 radios to the new P25 requirements. Major Seibles explained in last month's request for funding an error in cost was omitted and an additional \$12,848.00 will be needed to complete the mandatory required updates. The updates must be completed by January 1, 2017. Councilman Miller request the Major check with Fairfield County to see which system the county would be using. Councilman Sanders made a motion to table the decision at this time. Seconded by Councilman Miller and all vote aye.

Councilman Klaus made a motion with a second by Councilman Sanders to go into Executive Session to discuss: pursuant to SC Code Section 30-4-70 (a) (2): All voted aye.

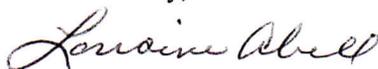
- a. Legal/Contractual: Water/Sewer- McCulley Creek Sewer Project

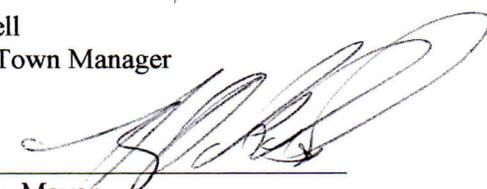
Questions from Media - None
