JACKSON/MILL CREEK RESERVOIR RESTRICTIONS

To protect water quality the Town of Winnsboro, as owner of the Jackson/Mill Creek Reservoir, located off Road 61 on Reservoir Road in Fairfield County, has placed certain restrictions on the reservoir itself and the surrounding areas. These restrictions are as follows:

- No gas-powered motorcraft are allowed in the reservoir
- No swimming
- No piers or docks can be constructed
- No structures, buildings, trees, undergrowth or shrubs can be constructed or planted within 15 feet, measured horizontally, of the contour line of 405 feet above mean sea level

Fishing is permitted in the reservoir. The fish population consists of bream, catfish, bass, crappie and shell-crappie.

The State Regulations 61-56 concerning Individual Waste Disposal Systems shall govern the installation of a septic tank system. These regulations state that "no part of the septic tank system shall be within a minimum of fifty (50) linear feet of the mean high water elevation (tidal waters) or ordinary high water (within the banks) elevation (non-tidal waters) of an impounded or natural body of water, including streams and canals.

Any well construction will be subject to State regulations that govern well installation.

Any building construction will be subject to the regulations of Fairfield County Building and Zoning Division.
