**Questions from Media – None**

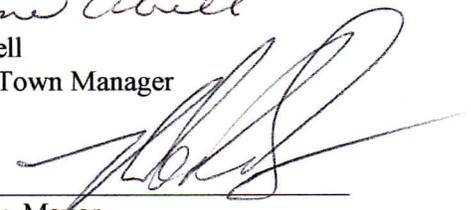
