Call to Order

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

New Business

a. Capital Expense Request: Otis Williams, Water Treatment Plant

A request for equipment and equipment updates was presented at the Finance Meeting. The Finance Committee recommended the request be approved by Council. Councilman Wilkes made a motion for approval; seconded by Councilman Sanders. All voted aye.

b. Downtown Events Funding: Terry Vickers, Fairfield Chamber of Commerce

Ms. Vickers made a presentation to Council about upcoming events and assisting the Town with the events. Chili Cook Off and Paw Show/Parade in April and the Mother's Day Side Walk Sale in May. There was discussion of Shag'n in the Street Dance concerning changing the day and expenses. Ms. Vickers had requested \$8,700.00. Council wanted to know of ways to reduce cost. No decisions were made by Council.
