Call to Order:

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Invocation:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell Prather offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes:

Councilman McMeekin made a motion to accept the minutes with a second by Councilwoman Janice Bartell Prather that the minutes of the May 15, 2018, Finance Meeting and Town Council Meeting be approved as written. All voted aye.

Public Comments: Jenyfer Conaway addressed Council stating she and Ms. Carnes had met with Councilman Sanders and it was a productive meeting.
Ms. Wanda Carnes spoke on problems with the website having nowhere to complain and the link from the County website did not work properly.
Mr. Tim Jones spoke requesting use of Friendship Park and free electricity for a Family and Friends Day on June 23rd from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. provided by his Lodge – Fidelity Lodge #33. Councilman Miller made a motion granting the request and Councilwoman Bartell-Prather seconded the motion. All voted aye.

New Business:

a. 1st Reading Ordinance #061918A

This ordinance establishes the 2018-19 Budget for the Town of Winnsboro.

b. **1st Reading Ordinance #06918B**

This ordinance establishes the millage rate for the 2018-19 Budget Year.

c. **Chamber of Commerce Board Composition**

Mr. Wood explained the Chamber had requested that a council member be a member of the board for the Chamber. Mr. Wood stated that Councilman McMeekin had volunteered to fill the position. Councilman Miller made a motion to appoint Councilman McMeekin as an ex-officio member to the Chamber Board. Mayor Pro-tem Sanders seconded the motion. All voted aye.

d. **Fairfield County Animal Control Ordinance**

The Council reviewed an ordinance presented by Fairfield County. The Council felt the ordinance was too restrictive and hard to enforce. No action was taken.

e. **Capital Expense: Old Amory Restroom Rehab.**

Mr. Wood and Mr. Castles explained the renovations for the ladies restroom at the Armory. The total cost would be approximately \$22,050.00. Councilwoman Bartell-Prather made a motion approving the repairs to the restroom at the Armory. Mayor Pro-tem Sanders seconded the motion and all voted aye.

Other Business: Councilman Miller requested that if a large crime occurs, please let the council member of that district be notified. Chief Seibles stated he would notify Council.


d. **Legal/Contractual Fairfield Memorial Hospital: Utilities**
