Call to Order:

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Invocation:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather made a motion to accept the minutes of the May 7, 2019, Town Council Meeting and the May 9, 2019, Budget Work Session be approved as written. Councilman Danny Miller seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Public Comments: Ms. Sylvia Harrison thanked Council for the use of the Armory for Sylvia's Foundation Annual Scholarship Gala. Ms. Harrison stated the foundation has awarded two (2) scholarships to Ricard Winn and Ms. Harrison was waiting on the Fairfield School District to submit names to the foundation. Ms. Harrison stated she needed the students to apply for the funds.

Presentation:

Ms. Keryn Isenhoward with the Fairfiel County Breast Cancer Committee presented to Council a request to use Mt. Zion Green Walking Trail again this year for their second annual Breast Cancer Walk. The event will be held on October 19, 2019, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Ms. Isenhoward stated the walk would need electrical service and trash cans as provided last year. Ms. Isenhoward also provided information concerning breast cancer and other cancers.

Financial Sponsorship Request-Historic Winnsboro Brochure-Earrestine Williams was tabled until a later date.

New Business:

- a. Capital Expense Request for a Forklift Shelter was presented to Council as a recommendation from the Finance Committee. The total cost is \$4,700.00. All vote aye.
- b. Capital Expense Request for a Scag 48" Zero Turn Mower was presented to Council as a recommendation from the Finance Committee. The total cost is \$8,500.00. Council unanimously approved the purchase of the mower.
- c. Capital Expense Request for a heat/air unit for the water plant was presented too Council as a recommendation from the Finance Committee. The total cost is \$15,000.00. Council approved the purchase of the heat/air unit.

Old Business:

Mayor Gaddy inquired when DNR would be attending a Council meeting. Mr. Wood stated DNR will be at the June 18th Council meeting to discuss issues concerning deer.

Other Business:

Mayor Gaddy informed Councilman Miller that the video taping of the meeting was to costly and the Finance Committee stated they were not in favor of recording because they had not had any concerns from citizens. Councilman Miller stated he had citizens address him about the meetings not being on Channel 4. Councilman Miller requested it be tabled until we could investigate other options. Council agreed to table the discussion.
