Call to Order:

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Councilman Danny Miller offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather made a motion to accept the minutes of the June 4, 2019, Town Council Meeting be approved as written. Councilman John McMeekin seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Presentation:

Mr. Charles Ruth addressed Council concerning deer population control.

Mr. Ruff stated there was three possible options the town could choose:

1. Just live with it – use fencing and repellents.
2. Recreational bow hunting in large wooden areas – this would require property owners agreeing to allow the hunting on property and rules drawn up for the hunters to follow.
3. Contract removal – this would be very expensive and require special permitting

Mr. Ruth and his staff recommended recreational bow hunting would be the best option for the town. Mr. Ruff stated DNR would assist the town if necessary. Mayor Gaddy and Council thanked Mr. Ruff.
