Call to Order:

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Invocation:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes:

Mayor Pro-tem John McMeekin made a motion to accept the minutes of the September 17, 2019, Town Council Meeting be approved as written. Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Presentation:

Ms. Katherine Doty presented to Council a request for endorsement and support for a Plant America Community Project Grant. The Gardening Girls Study Club will be submitting the grant on October 15, 2019, for a sign for Fortune Springs Park. Ms. Doty presented a brief video on Mr. Robert Marvin, Architect of Fortune Springs Park. Ms. Doty explained what they were applying for on the grant and how the sign would look and improvements to the park the club would like to make. Mayor Pro-tem McMeekin made a motion to endorse the project and provide up to \$1,000.00 for the sign. Councilwoman Bartell-Prather seconded the motion. All voted aye. Councilman Miller offered the services of Ms. Cyndi Gawronski, Grant Administrator, if the club needed assistance in preparing the grant.

Ms. Susie Clinard spoke requesting support for the project.

New Business:

a. Capital Expense Public Safety – Bill Castles

Mr. Bill Castles spoke on the behalf of Public Safety. Mr. Castles stated twice in the last two weeks the air has stopped working on the first floor of Public Safety and both times Alltemp Comfort Services has repaired the unit. The unit is old and cannot be repaired anymore. The request is to replace the air unit with a new heating and air unit. The total cost of the unit is \$6,900.00 including installation. Because of the availability of the unit and the rapid repair Mr. Castles stated Alltemp was the only company that could start the work within a week or less. Councilman Miller made a motion to approve the request for the new heating and air unit for Public Safety totaling \$6,900.00. Councilman Chatman seconded the motion and all voted aye.
