**Call to Order:**

Mayor Gaddy called the work session to order at 6:15 p.m. and turned the floor over to Don Wood, Town Manager for the presentation and Deliberation of the FY 2020-21 Annual Budget – Draft #3.

**New Business:**

Mr. Wood presented the third draft of the Budget for FY 2020-21 to Council. Mr. Wood stated that per Council's directions any increases in salary were changed just to reflect the 2.9% cost of living and no other increase in salaries will be granted at the present time. Also as Council requested, no capital expenditures would be approved for six months, unless it was an emergency request. Council agreed the Budget was ready for first reading in June.

**Other Business:**

Second Reading on Ordinance #05122020 was presented to Council. This ordinance temporarily suspends Ordinance # 113.02 curbside service prohibited and allows curbside service due to the Covid-19, Pandemic. Council also discussed outside dining but decided to wait and see how many restaurants opened for inside dining.
