Call to Order:

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order at 6:20 p.m.

Invocation:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather offered the Invocation.

Approval of Minutes:

Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather made a motion to accept the minutes of the Finance Meeting and Town Council Meeting of July 21, 2020, be approved as written. Councilman Demetrius Chatman seconded the motion. All voted aye.

Presentation:

Proclamation: Fairfield County Schools Superintendent Dr. J.R. Green, South Carolina Superintendent of the Year
Mayor Gaddy presented the proclamation and congratulated Dr. Green on receiving the S.C. Superintendent of the Year. Mayor Gaddy noted the accomplishments of Dr. Green and noted these accomplishments are what made Dr. Greene worthy of the Superintendent of the Year Award. Councilman Miller thanked Dr. Greene for his dedication to Fairfield County Schools and the community.

New Business:

- a. Capital Expense Request Wastewater Plant
Mr. Sammie Robinson, Director of Wastewater Plant presented a request for a loader for sludge collection and removal. Mr. Robinson presented quotes for a new, leased and used loaders. Mr. Robinson stated he felt the used loader would fill the needs of the department. The cost of 1998 Kamatsu is \$29,000.00 and a new loader would be \$156,161.04. The Mayor inquired if the used loader had been check out for issues. Mr. Robinson stated that Trip Peak and Bill Castles had looked at the loader. Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather made a motion to approve the purchase of the used loader for \$29,000.00. The motion was seconded by Councilman Demetrius Chatman. All voted aye.

Old Business:

- a. Zion Hill Prevention Save the Kids Back to School Bash-Amendment Request
Zion Hill requested an increase of \$200.00 because they were not using the Armory this year. Councilman Danny Miller made a motion to increase the request \$200.00. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Janice Bartell-Prather. All voted aye.

Other Business:

Councilman McMeekin inquired about an Armory rental for next April. In an early meeting, Council had stated there would be no rentals with the exceptions of the two weddings that were to be held in December, 2020 and January 2021.


None heard.
