TOWN OF WINNSBORO)	AUGUST 21, 2012

WHEREAS, in February of 2012, the Town of Winnsboro found its reservoir contained only 60 days of water for Winnsboro Water Customers; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, in response to the emergency, issued an Extreme Drought Proclamation ordering customers to cut back personal use and prohibiting landscape irrigation, car washing and the washing down of sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts and other hard surfaces; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, on August 21, 2012, issued an Amended Extreme Drought Proclamation releasing the Blythewood portions of the Town's Water System from drought restrictions when a water supply for that area was secured through an emergency water connection with the City of Columbia, but continuing the restrictions on Fairfield County Customers for the purpose of allowing the reduced water consumption and nature to raise levels in the reservoir; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council find that the rains in Fairfield County now have raised the Town's reservoir to full pool; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council wish to thank those, who supported Winnsboro by reducing their water purchases during this emergency, and end their sacrifices now that the reservoir has achieved full pool.

THEREFORE, I, Roger Gaddy, Mayor, with appreciation and thanks to all, who supported Winnsboro during this extended period of drought, herein proclaim and ordain that the Extreme Drought Proclamation, as Amended on August 21, 2012, is terminated and revoked.
