Call to Order

Mayor Gaddy called the meeting to order.

Invocation

The Invocation was offered by Councilman Klaus.

Approval of Minutes

Councilman Klaus made a motion that the minutes of July 15, 2014 Town Council meeting, the July 15, 2014 Finance Meeting, the July 17, 2014 Work Session, and July 24, 2014 Special Called Meeting be approved with corrections. Councilman Sanders seconded and all voted aye.

Public Comments

1. **Bill Haslett** – asked permission to have a World War II Monument installed at the Memorial Park. Also he asked to have a walking path with brick pavers which would cost \$25-35,000 that

would tie in with the Mount Zion project. He requested \$5,000 from the Town of Winnsboro to be donated to this project.

2. **Sarah Bryant** – 1. Thanked Council for the two ordinances that were passed. 2. Asked the Town of Winnsboro to work on Economic Development by supporting businesses downtown.

1. **Terry Vickers, Chamber of Commerce** – she stated that were two events coming up that the Chamber was sponsoring: 1. The Big Grab, a 43 mile yard sale on September 5th and 6th; 2. Rock Around the Clock on October 3rd and 4th. She asked permission to use the entire downtown area for Rock Around the Clock. Councilman Klaus made a motion to approve these requests with a second by Councilman Sanders. All voted aye.

2. **Christina Fair, Winnsboro Merchants Group** – she stated that on August 14th there will be a Spirit Fest from 6:45-8:30 pm. On October 25th there will be a Pumpkin Fest from 5:30 – 8:30 and she requested that the street be closed from South Congress to Liberty Streets. She requested that the Christmas Parade be moved to November 23rd and that the Christmas lights not be turned on until after the parade. On December 31st she stated that there would be a Street Party and Ball drop at the Town Clock with music and live entertainment. Councilman Klaus made a motion to approve these request with a second by Mayor Pro tem Wilkes. All voted aye.

Kathy Timms stated how amazing the Spirit Fest was last year.
