



WINNSBORO CHRISTMAS PARADE

NOVEMBER 27, 2016 at 4 PM

You are invited to join our parade on Sunday, November 27, 2016 to kick off the 2016 Christmas Season. The parade will begin at 4 PM and go south on Congress Street from Evans to Moultrie Streets. Following the parade, the Town Christmas Tree (in front of the Town Clock) will be lighted, Santa will be visiting with the children on the first floor of the clock building, and there will be other holiday activities for the whole family. We encourage you to stay downtown and visit local shops. There will be only one live SANTA CLAUS in the Parade provided by the Town at end of Parade.

THROWING CANDY IS NOT ALLOWED. IT IS DANGEROUS AS CHILDREN RUN OUT INTO THE STREET AND COULD BE HIT BY A CAR. You are allowed to have someone walk beside the float /vehicle and hand it out directly. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THIS RULE IS FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR CHILD/REN. SANTA WILL BE HANDING OUT CANDY AT THE TOWN CLOCK AFTER THE PARADE. Parents can take pictures with Santa please bring your own camera.

LINE UP – Begins at 3 PM on Evans Street between Congress and Hwy 200 (Newberry Rd). Participants should come in from Hwy 200 and line up along the curb. There will be staff there to help you get in the proper place.

Please decorate your vehicle in keeping with the holiday. Please no loud music or vehicles.

There is no charge to be in the parade; however, you must register no later than November 21.
