Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Presentations

1. **Brenda Miller** – Ms. Miller was present to give Council an update on work in progress regarding Mount Zion. She thanked Public Safety for helping with security of the buildings and sign. Mayor Gaddy stated that some citizens had complained about rodents around the buildings and she said that they were taking care of that issue. She expressed that the Mount Zion fundraisers had been successful and more are planned for the future. Mayor Gaddy thanked her for coming.

1. **Second Reading & Public Hearing of Ordinances #060314A and #060314B** – Ordinance #060314A: "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET PROPOSED BY THE TOWN MANAGER, CONTAINING ESTIMATES OF PROPOSED REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES BY THE TOWN OF WINNSBORO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2015 AND DECLARING THAT THE SAME SHALL CONSTITUTE THE BUDGET OF THE TOWN OF WINNSBORO FOR SUCH FISCAL YEAR."
2. Ordinance #060314B: "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR ORDINARY TOWN PURPOSES IN THE TOWN OF WINNSBORO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014 TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENDITURES THEREOF"

Mayor Gaddy opened the floor for comments. With no comments for or against, Mayor Gaddy closed the Public Hearing. Councilman Sanders made a motion with a second by Mayor Pro Tem Wilkes to approve Ordinance #060314A and Ordinance #060314B. All voted aye.

Other Business

1. **Hanging Baskets Request – Connie Shackelford, Grants/Community Development – Ms.** Shackelford asked permission to hang baskets and fill them with flowers. She stated that they would be installed by the electrical department. After some discussion, Councilman Miller suggested that Ms. Shackelford meet with Town Manager Wood and work out the details of this project.
2. Councilman Sanders brought up the issue of dress code and baggy pants and suggested that the Town Attorney research the possibility of adopting an ordinance regarding this problem. Councilman Miller agreed and stated that something should be done about the vulgar music that is coming from cars in the Town.
3. Councilman Sanders suggested that Council schedule a work session and ask Attorney Margaret Pope to come and give any information regarding the possibility of funds available to help in getting water from Lake Monticello. Mayor Gaddy suggested that Town Manager Wood pursue this matter.
4. Councilman Wilkes suggested that the water hydrants in Town be painted.
