

Town Council Budget Work Session Minutes of April 08, 2021

The Town of Winnsboro Council met in a budget work session April 8, 2021, at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Old Armory (due to Covid-19). Following normal procedures, copies of the agenda were provided to Council, The Voice and the Country Chronicle. Those in attendance were:

Call to Order: Mayor Gaddy called the work session at 6:15 p.m.

New Business:

A. Presentation and Deliberation of FY 2020-21 General Fund Budget

Mr. Wood discussed in detail the revenues and expenditures of the General Fund proposed budget and capital expenditures.

Main items discussed by Council were:

Salaries increase for Council. Council salaries can only be increased after an election. Council agreed to increase 5% which would be the COL that the employees received over the last two years. Council requested a listing of salaries by department. This would be discussed in Executive Session and must remain confidential. Council discussed the salary of the new Zoning director, since this will become a part time position.

Council inquired about Municipal Court budget figures being the same as last year. Mr. Wood stated that the Courts did not submit a budget and inquiries were made several times. Mr. Wood stated that Judge Goode would be the responsible person for submitting the budget.

Other Business:

Mayor Gaddy informed Council that the contract for the new town manager had been negotiated and signed. Mayor Pro-tem made a motion to endorse the contract for a new town manager, Mr. Jason Taylor. The motion was seconded by Councilman Demetrius Chatman. All voted aye.


